## NOTICE

The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control invites comment from the public on a report describing cleanup of landfill BW-7 at ATK Bacchus Facility located in Magna, Utah. The report describes excavation of industrial waste and contaminated soil from the landfill. The report also includes data from soil samples collected after the excavation was complete. Based on the sample data, the report concludes all the waste and contaminated soil was removed and the soil is now suitable for unrestricted soil use as defined in R315-101 of the Utah Administrative Code.

The 30-day public comment period on the cleanup report for BW-7 will commence on October 13, 2015 and end November 12, 2015. A public hearing may be held if, within 15 days of publication of this notice, a request is made to the Director in writing which meets the requirements of R315-311-3 of the Utah Administrative Code.
