The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control invites public comment on a proposed modification to the Used Oil Transporter Permit Modification for Emerald Services, Inc. (Emerald). Emerald has requested removal of the requirement to track used oil transportation vehicles using vehicle identification numbers. The permit also needs to be reformatted in accordance with changes to R315-15 of the Utah Administration Code.
