NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT  
DRAFT PHASE II RCRA FACILITY INVESTIGATION REPORT ADDENDUM  
SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT UNIT (SWMU) 30  
TOOELE ARMY DEPOT SOUTH (TEADS) AREA

The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control invites comments from the public regarding a Phase II RFI Report Addendum for SWMU 30 at TEADS. The addendum includes a no further action proposal. SWMU 30 has four main areas including a landfill with three trenches, a wastewater runoff ditch, a wastewater lagoon and a large surface disposal area. The waste in landfill trenches was removed and soil samples were collected after the removal. The post-excavation soil samples indicate the soil in this area qualifies for unrestricted soil use, but groundwater monitoring will be required. Soil data from the other areas indicates these areas qualify for unrestricted land use or No Further Action (NFA) as defined in R315-101 of the Utah Administrative Code.

The public comment period to receive comments on the addendum will commence on September 8, 2016 and end on October 7, 2016.
