Terms and Conditions

Acceptance as a Clean Utah Entry Level participant entitles the facility to technical assistance in developing an EMS and to designation on the DEQ website and other publicity as one who is interested in and has started the *Clean Utah* process.

Each Clean Utah Entry Level participant will develop and implement an Environmental Management System (EMS). Several EMS models currently exist, including ISO-14001, and the applicant is free to select the model which best meets the facility's circumstances. Any model selected must include each of the 12 components outlined in the Clean Utah policy. (Available on line at www.deq.utah.gov/cleanutah)

To remain in the program, an EMS must be completed and operational within two years of being accepted into the program. Those who desire to move onto the Partner Level must document that the EMS has been implemented for one full cycle. In addition, two projects designed to significantly reduce or prevent pollution must be proposed. Ideally, these projects should be based on aspects identified in the EMS process. (Additional information is available online.)

Clean Utah participants agree to remain in compliance with applicable environmental regulations. Failure to do so may be grounds for removal.

The Marriott Salt Lake City Center supports the vision to be a Utah hospitality leader by incorporating sustainable environmental practices. Below are some of the practices we are currently using to aid our guests and associates in protecting the environment:

We have formed an on-property environmental “Green Team” involving Hotel Associates from all Departments. We are currently exploring and pursuing new ways to reduce energy and water consumption and additional ways to recycle in addition to what we are already doing as outlined below:

- We currently have a “Guest Linen Re-Use Program” in effect. Guests are given an option to re-use towels, bed linens etc. for multiple nights stays to reduce water consumption, chemical use, etc.
- We currently have recycle containers on each of the guestroom floors in which papers, newspaper, plastic bottles, aluminum cans are separated from guest trash and recycled in appropriate containers. Since we have started a recycle program we have reduced, on average, our trash disposal in our large trash receptacle by 16,000 – 20,000 pounds of waste monthly.
- Currently, all guests do not get a newspaper left outside their guestroom door, they are instead asked upon check-in if they would like a newspaper. This has reduced newspaper ordering and it’s subsequent waste significantly.
- All Pens and Paper Products used in Guestrooms, Meeting Rooms, Restaurant and Lounge and Administrative Offices are made from between 74% - 100% Recycled Post Consumer Waste.
- Our Housekeeping Department Utilizes “Green” cleaning and disinfecting products. As well, they utilize “low temperature” linen cleaning agents.
- Recycling Program in Lobby and on Meeting Room Levels with Recycle bins in public space for Paper, Plastic and Aluminum.
- Majority of batteries used on property are rechargeable. Batteries which are not re-chargeable are recycled (see attached)
- Recycle Kitchen Grease.
- All Hazardous Materials used and disposed of on-site are stored in appropriate double-walled labeled containers.
- 100% use of high efficiency fluorescent lighting and light bulbs throughout the Hotel.
- Outdoor area’s surrounding hotel are swept rather than power washed or hosed down.

- Promote Guest/Group use of Water Pitches and Glassware in Meetings rather than plastic bottled water.
