Dear Mr. Edwards:

With this letter, I am forwarding the proposed one-year contract and work plan for FY13. The total funding allotment for Salt Lake Valley Health Department for FY13 is \$103,988. This represents:

- Decreased radon funding from \$1,000 to \$500. As we discussed at the last Local Health Officer Meeting, EPA has indicated that it is cutting the Radon grant funding however, we wanted to continue it in FY13 and then see if we could find a way to fund it in the future.
- Decrease in Used Oil Funds back down to \$10,160. This total is the same for all health departments, however, last year, Tri-County had opted not to participate and its share of the funds was sent to you. This year, Darren Brown has opted back in and, as we discussed with Dr. DeLegge, the funds were returned to the previous level.
- All other funding remains the same.

Funding and adjustments become effective July 1, 2012. Annual reports on current fiscal year work are due by August 31, 2012. As we did last year, an e-mail with the simplified reporting form will be sent out in late July.

Please review these documents and, if you are in agreement, sign and return them. If you have concerns, let Renette Anderson know and she will work with you to resolve them.
