PUBLIC NOTICE OF REISSUANCE OF A UPDES PERMIT

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC NOTICE IS TO DECLARE THE STATE OF UTAH'S INTENTION TO REISSUE A UTAH POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (UPDES) PERMIT UNDER AUTHORITY OF THE UTAH WATER QUALITY ACT, SECTION 19-5-104 AND 107, UTAH CODE ANNOTATED 1953, AS AMENDED. SAID "PERMIT" REFERS TO UPDES PERMIT AND THE STATEMENT OF BASIS (INCLUDING THE TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOADS (TMDL'S)) IF APPLICABLE, AS PER SECTION 303 (d) OF THE FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT (CWA).

BACKGROUND

The (BCWTP) Brigham City Wastewater Treatment Plant has design capacity of 6.0 Million Gallons per day. BCWTP has an activated sludge treatment process with ultra violet (UV) disinfection. The BCWTP treats wastewater from Brigham City, Mantua and Proctor and Gamble. The sludge generated from the ditches is dried and composted onsite, then utilized for landscape and gardening purposes. The permit has biosolids, storm water and pretreatment components.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Public comments are invited any time prior to close of business on October 4, 2013. A public hearing can be requested but must be filed during the 30 day comment period which will end on October 4, 2013 at the close of business. A request for a public hearing must be filed per the requirement of R317-8-6.6. After considering public comment the Division of Water Quality may execute the permit reissuance, revise it, or abandon it.
