PUBLIC NOTICE OF RENEWAL OF A UPDES PERMIT

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC NOTICE IS TO DECLARE THE STATE OF UTAH'S INTENTION TO REISSUE A UTAH POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (UPDES) PERMIT UNDER AUTHORITY OF THE UTAH WATER QUALITY ACT, SECTION 19-5-104 AND 107, UTAH CODE ANNOTATED 1953, AS AMENDED. SAID "PERMIT" REFERS TO UPDES PERMIT AND THE STATEMENT OF BASIS (INCLUDING THE TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOADS (TMDL'S)) IF APPLICABLE, AS PER SECTION 303 (d) OF THE FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT (CWA).

BACKGROUND

Casper's Ice Cream produces novelty ice cream products as well as hard ice cream. Two pipes leave the Casper Facility, one contains non-contact cooling water and the other contains process water. The process water is currently being run through several grease traps, septic tanks, and to an aerated containment pond and then disposed of on cropland located west of the facility. The cooling water will be discharged to the Cub River or blended with the process water in the aerated containment.
