PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC NOTICE IS TO SOLICIT PUBLIC COMMENT REGARDING CEDAR CITY WATER RECLAMATION FACILITIES INTENTION TO SUBSTANTIALLY MODIFY ITS PRETREATMENT REGULATIONS REGARDING LOCAL LIMITS. THE LOCAL LIMITS HAVE BEEN REVIEWED AND ONCE THE PUBLIC NOTICE AND COMMENT PROCESS IS COMPLETED; IT IS THE DIVISION OF WATER QUALITY'S INTENTION TO FORMALLY APPROVE THESE MODIFICATIONS.

BACKGROUND

Cedar City Water Reclamation Facility has modified its Industrial Pretreatment Program by re-evaluating its local limits which apply to significant industrial dischargers. The modified local limits will impact industrial users discharging to the Cedar City treatment plant.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Public comments are invited any time prior to the deadline of the close of business on July 1, 2013. Written public comments can be submitted to: Matthew Garn, UPDES Engineering Section, Utah Division of Water Quality, P.O. Box 144870, Salt Lake City, Utah 84114-4870 or by email at: mgarn@utah.gov. After considering public comment the Utah Water Quality Director (Director) may execute the modifications, revise it, or abandon it.

A public hearing can be requested but must be filed during the 30 day comment period which will end on July 1, 2013 at the close of business. A request for a public hearing must be filed per the requirement of 40 CFR 403.11. After considering public comments the Director may approve the Pretreatment Local limits, revise it, or abandon it. The Director will not publish a notice of decision provided: the Cedar City Water Reclamation Facility will be approve without any changes to the local limits and no comments are received during the public comment period.
