PUBLIC NOTICE TO REISSUE A UPDES PERMIT

**PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE**

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC NOTICE IS TO DECLARE THE STATE OF UTAH'S INTENTION TO REISSUE A UTAH POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (UPDES) PERMIT UNDER AUTHORITY OF THE UTAH WATER POLLUTION CONTROL ACT, SECTION 19-5-104(9) AND 107(2), UTAH CODE ANNOTATED 1953, AS AMENDED. SAID "PERMIT" REFERS TO THE UPDES PERMIT AND THE FACT SHEET STATEMENT OF BASIS (INCLUDING TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOADS (TMDL'S)) IF APPLICABLE, AS PER SECTION 303(D) OF THE FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT (CWA)].

**BACKGROUND**

The effluent from the wastewater treatment facility is discharged from outfall 001 to the Great Salt Lake. The design flow of the facility is 9.9 million gallons a day (MGD), with a design population equivalent of 65,000 people and an allowance for industrial waste. The discharge, Outfall 001, is located at latitude 40°59'54" and longitude 111°57'01". The CDSO serves the cities of Farmington, Fruit Heights, and Kaysville. The facility is located in Kaysville, Davis County, Utah. The permit has biosolids, pretreatment, and storm water industrial components.
