NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT
ROC Intermountain Regional Landfill Major Permit Modification

The Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control has completed its review of a major permit modification for the ROC Intermountain Regional Landfill located three miles south, southeast of Fairfield in Utah County, Utah. The modification consists of a redesign of the landfill floor, leachate collection system and closure cap. These design modifications maintain the previous permitted footprint of the landfill but decrease the total depth of the floor excavation from 50 feet to 37 feet. The overall capacity of the landfill has been increased slightly due to the redesign.

The public comment period on the permit modification begins February 2, 2017 and will end March 6, 2017. Documents related to this modification can be reviewed at the following location:

All documents included in comments should be submitted as ASCII (text) files or in pdf format.
