DIVISION OF WATER QUALITY UTAH DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY PUBLIC NOTICE OF REISSUANCE OF A UPDES PERMIT

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

The purpose of this public notice is to declare the State of Utah's intention to reissue a Utah Pollution Discharge Elimination System (UPDES) Permit under authority of the Utah Water Pollution Control Act, Section 19-5-104(9) and 107(2), Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended. Said "permit" refers to the UPDES Permit and the Fact Sheet Statement of Basis (including Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDL's)) if applicable, as per Section 303(d) of the Federal Clean Water Act (CWA).

BACKGROUND

The Moab Wastewater Treatment Facility (Moab) was originally built in the early fifties, and currently has a design capacity of 1.5 million gallons a day (MGD) after two minor upgrades in 1983 and in 1996. Currently Moab is at approximately two-thirds its organic and hydraulic loading capacity. Moab's engineers and consultants have determined that the facility will not exceed design capacity during the lifetime of this permit, and have been working on plans for facility upgrades. Moab City is currently working to finalize plans and arrange funding for the project. This permit also has Biosolids and Industrial Storm Water components.
