PUBLIC NOTICE TO REISSUE A UPDES PERMIT

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC NOTICE IS TO DECLARE THE STATE OF UTAH'S INTENTION TO ISSUE A UTAH POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (UPDES) PERMIT UNDER AUTHORITY OF THE UTAH WATER POLLUTION CONTROL ACT, SECTION 19-5-104(9) AND 107(2), UTAH CODE ANNOTATED 1953, AS AMENDED. SAID "PERMIT" REFERS TO THE UPDES PERMIT AND THE FACT SHEET STATEMENT OF BASIS (INCLUDING TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOADS (TMDL'S)) IF APPLICABLE, AS PER SECTION 303(D) OF THE FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT (CWA)].

BACKGROUND

The Mountain Green Wastewater Treatment Facility (MGWTF) is a discharging lagoon system which was constructed in 1989 and upgraded in 2007/2008. The upgrade increased the treatment capacity from a population of about 2500 persons to about 6750 persons. Current population being served is about 2500 persons. The design flow for the facility is 0.61 million gallons per day. The facility is under the alternate discharge limits for TSS and BOD of 65 mg/L daily maximum and 45 mg/L 7 day average. The MGWTF is meeting the alternate discharge limits.
