Dear Mr. Anderson:

A meeting was held on December 9, 2015, with members of your staff and Rio Algom Mining LLC's (RAML's) senior technical team to review the key components of the referenced Work Plan. All agreed that an additional groundwater monitoring well should be installed in the northwestern area of the Site to address concerns about localized groundwater flow conditions. The attached Addendum Figure 3 illustrates the proposed monitoring well network, including the new well MW-129.

As also discussed with your staff, the schedule for all activities provided in the Work Plan is aggressive and we will need to begin the permitting process for well installation immediately. As discussed with Mr. Phil Goble, we understand that it will be possible to obtain DWMRC approval of the proposed well locations in advance of completing the Work Plan review which we understand is not likely to occur before early March 2016.



