PUBLIC NOTICE OF REISSUANCE OF STORM WATER PERMIT

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC NOTICE IS TO DECLARE THE STATE OF UTAH'S INTENTION TO REISSUE A STORM WATER PERMIT UNDER AUTHORITY OF THE UTAH WATER QUALITY ACT, SECTION 19-5-104 (9) AND 107 (2), UTAH CODE ANNOTATED 1953, AS AMENDED. SAID "STORM WATER PERMIT" REFERS TO THE UTAH POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (UPDES) PERMIT AND THE STATEMENT OF BASIS. (INCLUDING TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOADS (TMDL'S)) IF APPLICABLE, AS PER SECTION 303(D) OF THE FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT (CWA)].

BACKGROUND

The permit authorizes discharges of storm water from the Salt Lake City International Airport. Included in the permit are specific requirements for 5 discreet storm water outfall locations as well as requirements for storm water management at the facility in general. The permit requires the implementation and maintenance of a "storm water pollution prevention plan."
