PUBLIC NOTICE OF REISSUANCE OF A UPDES PERMIT

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC NOTICE IS TO DECLARE THE STATE OF UTAH'S INTENTION TO REISSUE A UTAH POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (UPDES) PERMIT UNDER AUTHORITY OF THE UTAH WATER QUALITY ACT, SECTION 19-5-104 AND 107, UTAH CODE ANNOTATED 1953, AS AMENDED. SAID "PERMIT" REFERS TO UPDES PERMIT AND THE STATEMENT OF BASIS (INCLUDING THE TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOADS (TMDL'S)) IF APPLICABLE, AS PER SECTION 303 (d) OF THE FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT (CWA).

BACKGROUND

St. George Regional water reclamation facility (SGWRF) began discharging in 1990 with a 5 MGD design capacity, was upgraded in 1994 to an 8.5 MGD capacity, and the latest upgrade was completed in 1999 bringing the plant design capacity to an average daily flow of 17 MGD. This treatment plant is serving St. George and the surrounding areas of Ivins, Santa Clara and Washington City. The St George permit includes Biosolids, Pretreatment and Storm Water provisions.
