Just a few things on our listings:

- 1) SF of Sixmile is listed as insufficient data (geomean 292 CFU), yet it was a proper 5 sample geomean
- 2) Many sites had astronomical turbidity levels Both Sage Cr's and SF Sixmile) but no listings. What is needed for turb listings?
- 3) Otter Creek 195 CFU geomean) (and all the creeks data was submitted for) are listed as 2B secondary contact, but many support primary and are in high recreation areas. How does the 2B square with the CWA rebuttable presumption principle? Otter Creek and Big Creek are both major rec areas. I see families in campers out there from May through Oct. I have seen kids playing in both. This may also be a broader issue that has never been dealt with since you are just getting into e coli issue. You are in a different EPA region but Reg 8 disapproved WY's categorical downgrade to secondary
